A STRATEGIC COMMITMENT TO WALKING AND BICYCLING

"...plan, prioritize and fund the timely construction and maintenance of interconnected systems or networks of walkways and bikeways with special focus on connecting centers of population with destinations such as workplaces, schools, residences, businesses, recreation areas and other community activity centers in order to provide safe, convenient, cost-effective and healthy mobility via walking and bicycling..."

BUILD "OFF-ALIGNMENT" MULTI-USE PATHS

"...create multi-use paths for pedestrian and bicycle user travel within and between cities and towns in Delaware on independent right-of-way outside of the right-of-way of existing roadways..."


WILMINGTON-TO-NEWARK "OFF-ALIGNMENT" MULTI-USE PATH


WILMINGTON-TO-NEWARK "OFF-ALIGNMENT" MULTI-USE PATH
