Three Marked Course Route Options: 100K, 50K and 25 mile, plus a Kid's Ride!

Start and Finish:

Alexis I. duPont High School, 50 Hillside Road, Greenville, DE. Located off DE Rt. 52/Kennett Pike.

100K and 50K rides take cyclists through scenic New Castle County, DE and Chester County, PA traversing up to 15 of the most challenging hills in the area – Beaver Valley, Twaddell Mill, and Cannery, just to name a few. The 25 mile option provides a gently rolling course.

A 6-mile guided route will be provided for kids, including children from the Boys & Girls Clubs of Delaware.

Amenities include cool t-shirts, rest stops stocked with goodies, and post-ride refreshments and celebration!

Pre-Registration is \$25. Day-of Registration is \$35. Kids Ride is \$15.

If you would like to give a child who may not be able to afford to ride an opportunity to participate, please include the additional Kid's Ride fee with the registration fee.
